It's pretty accurate and if you don't know it and him, well, now's a good time to be introduced. We can't market anything and we can't air calls to action (even a free musical event). What we can do is point people to a website or Facebook page where that information is listed.
3. Maybe this is your first time on radio. Great. Some people say they get nervous. Its my job to be a good host and not only help you to feel welcome but also help you to sound good. After all I invited you on the show. Mistakes will happen; especially on live radio. Its all part of what makes it so dynamic.

6. We may be able to record the show. If so, I will post podcasts on my webpage.
